# REQUIREMENTS FOR ADVANCEMENT WITHIN THE TRIBE OF NANI-BA-ZHU

To advance through the paint stations, the following minimum standards should be met. Final decisions for advancements are made by the Tribal Council and Council of Chieftains. <u>Members</u> are required to wear their Claws at check-in as well as during their week at camp.

#### **BRAVE TO WARRIOR**

- 1. Should be a Life Scout
- 2. Show Scout Spirit
- 3. Meet regalia requirements for Brave\*
- 4. Have earned Indian Lore Merit Badge
- 5. Learn 10 words of sign language\*\*
- 6. Learn tribal dance steps (Side step and/or 2 step)\*\*
- 7. Must be a current camper or camp staff member at camp

### WARRIOR TO FIREBUILDER

- 1. Must be a Life Scout
- 2. Show Scout Spirit
- 3. Meet regalia requirements for Warrior\*
- 4. Show knowledge of building Tribal ceremonial fires\*\*
- 5. Demonstrate knowledge of sign language and dance\*\*
- 6. Must be a current camper or camp staff member at camp

### FIREBUILDER TO TOM-TOM BEATER

- 1. Should be an Eagle Scout
- 2. Show Scout Spirit
- 3. Meet regalia requirements for Firebuilder\*
- 4. Build and tend at least two ceremonial fires during Tribal ceremonies\*\*
- 5. Demonstrate knowledge of Tribal dances\*\*
- 6. Must be a current camper or camp staff member at camp

## TOM-TOM BEATER TO RUNNER

- 1. Must be an Eagle Scout
- 2. Show Scout Spirit
- 3. Meet regalia requirements for Tom-Tom Beater\*
- 4. Chant and serve as Tom-Tom Beater for at least one Tribal ceremony\*\*
- 5. Show knowledge of Tribal grounds
- 6. Must be a current camper or camp staff member at camp

#### RUNNER TO KEEPER OF THE SACRED BUNDLE

- 1. Be an Eagle Scout
- 2. Show Scout Spirit
- 3. Meet regalia requirements for Runner\*
- 4. Serve as Runner for at least one selection and induction ceremony\*\*
- 5. Demonstrate thorough knowledge of Tribal customs and traditions

- \*\* Instruction will be available at summer camp.
