

REGALIA REQUIREMENTS

The various paint stations of the Tribe of Nan-Ba-Zhu are recognized at ceremonies by the type of regalia worn. The level of paint station can be determined by the claw, paint on the claws, as well as the headdress and regalia worn. Further explanation of these requirements is given below. Additional required regalia is detailed on the Regalia Chart.

Brave

Braves will wear one claw that is mounted on a lanyard with no coup. They wear one feather mounted upright on a headband. The headband may be decorated with beadwork if the Brave so desires. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Warrior

Warriors will wear two claws mounted back to back with the tips pointed upward. (One piece Warrior claws are permitted.) They wear two feathers mounted upright in a headband. The headband may be decorated with beadwork if the Warrior so desires. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Honored Warrior

Honored Warriors will wear two claws mounted back to back with the tips pointed downward in a crescent shape. (One piece Honored Warrior claws are permitted.) They wear two feathers mounted upright in a headband. The headband may be decorated with beadwork if the Honored Warrior so desires. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Firebuilder

Firebuilders wear the claws of a Warrior with the tips decorated with orange paint. They wear three feathers mounted upright in a headband. The headband may be decorated with beadwork if the Firebuilder so desires. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Tom-Tom Beater

Tom-Tom Beaters wear the claws of the Warrior with the tips decorated with green paint. They wear four feathers mounted upright in a headband. The headband may be decorated with beadwork if the Tom-Tom Beater so desires. In addition, they will make a tom-tom beater according to the following:

- * The handle will be dime size or less, at the largest end with a length of 22 to 24 inches. It can be made out of fiberglass rod or hardwood such as hickory, osage orange, walnut, oak, etc.
- * The head will be one and a half to two inches in diameter with a length of four to six inches. The covering will be made out of soft leather, suede, fur, or goat hair, and the wrapping will be made out of masking tape, fur sponge, foam rubber or ace bandage.

Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Runner

Runners wear the claws of a Warrior with the tips decorated with blue paint. They wear a hair roach without feathers. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Keeper of the Sacred Bundle

The Keepers of the Sacred Bundle wear the claws of a Warrior with the tips decorated with yellow paint. They wear a hair roach with one feather mounted upright. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Shaman

The Shaman wear the claws of a Warrior with the tips decorated with lavender paint. They wear a hair roach with two feathers mounted upright. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Sachem, Keeper of the Wampum, and Sagamore

These members of the Tribal Council wear the claws of a Warrior or Honored Warrior with the tips decorated with white paint. (One piece Warrior or Honored Warrior claws are permitted.) They may wear any headdress not specifically mentioned for another paint station. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Guardian of the Council Fire

The Guardians of the Council Fire wear the claws of a Warrior or Honored Warrior with the tips decorated with white paint. They must carry a medicine pipe. They may wear any headdress not specifically mentioned for another paint station. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Medicine Man

The Medicine Men wear the claws of a Warrior or Honored Warrior with the tips decorated with white paint. They wear a horned bonnet. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.

Chief or Chieftain

The Chief or Chieftain wear the claws of a Warrior or Honored Warrior with the tips decorated with red paint. They wear a war bonnet. Additional regalia required is noted on the chart.
